## IN THE SUPREME COURT OF ALABAMA ORDER JUNE 10, 2020

Pursuant to this Court's order of June 5, 2020, related to the administration of funds appropriated by Act No. 2020-199, the Supreme Court of Alabama hereby appoints an Administrative Liaison to the Supreme Court of Alabama and hereby designates and appoints J. Langford Floyd to serve in such capacity with all the powers, duties and authorities to accomplish such tasks as assigned by the Court.

The Administrative Liaison shall have the sole authority to administer the approval, budgeting, allocation and distribution of the funds in accordance with federal and state regulations or other applicable guidelines and at the direction of the Supreme Court of Alabama.

The Administrative Liaison shall supervise and implement the aforesaid distribution of the funds and assist and guide the courts during the COVID-19 pandemic crisis.

To help and assist in the fulfilment of these duties, the Administrative Liaison may borrow personnel from the Unified Judicial System (including, but not limited to, the Administrative Office of Courts), who then shall work under his exclusive authority and direction to the exclusion of any other priority designated by any other supervisor. Furthermore, he shall have access to any and all information related to the administration of the funds and all resources of the judicial system necessary to carry out his assigned authority.
